Mr. Allamanis was born in 1910 at Carditsa (Thessaly).

Education: In 1930 he graduated from the University of Athens and from 1932 to 1945 he practiced law in Thessaly before moving to Athens. He also attended the French Institute of Athens, and the Faculte des Lettres of the University of Grenoble. Also, he was educated at the British Institute of Athens, the German School of Athens, and the Law School of the University of Gottingen.

Political Activity: He was elected to Parliament of EPEK (led by Plasteras and Kartalis) in the 1950, 1951 and 1952 elections. He assumed, then, the joint leadership of the Democratic Party of Working People (ΔΔΕΑ) and was elected to parliament in the 1956 and 1958 election. Finally, as a member of the Center Union Party, he was elected to parliament in the 1961, 1963, and 1964 elections. He was a member of the Political Bureau of the Center Union and the Liberal Democratic Party (ΔΔΚ). He was the co-chairman of the ΔΔΕΑ party from 1953-57, and the Chairman from 1957-60. The ΔΔΕΑ had 20 deputies in parliament.

He was Minister of Agriculture (1951-52), Public Works (1963), Transportation (1964-5), Finance and Public Order (1965), and Education (1965-66).

He was a member of the Greek Parliamentary Delegation at the Council of Europe (1950-60) and in his capacity of minister or deputy he has visited a number of countries to attend various conferences.
