Στὴν νίκη τῶν Βαλκανικῶν συμμάχων τὸ 1912 - ποὺ μαζί μὲ τ' ἄλλα  
ξέπλυνε καὶ τὸ ἔθνος τοῦ '97-ἀποφασιστικῶ συνέταλασε, ὡς γνωστὸ, ἡ  
ναυτικὴ μας ὑπεροχὴ ἀπὸ Αἰγαῖο ποὺ τὴν ἐξησφάλισε ἡ ἔγκαιρη ὑπάρξι

Sir,

With reference to your editorial comment on the Cyprus developments in conjunction with Mr Michael Fields' special article in your 20th August issue, may I observe the following.

Stating half truths is obviously the most convenient and effective way of misleading the Public and falsifying facts.

Pro Turkish bias is, & with few exceptions always has been, an integral part of your foreign policy. Understandably so, from a purely British viewpoint, ever since the imperial Russia's threat to the Med. In this particular case your attitude is, moreover, also sentimentally, let us say, justified, in view of the fact that it was the Greek, not any Turkish, Cypriot Freedomfighters who gave the lie to Lord Avon's unforgettable naive "N E V E R" with regard to the ending of British rule in Cyprus. The Turks, were the factor whose help you enlisted in a desperate effort to save one of the last remnants of the defunct, unfortunately for the World as a whole, British Empire. It is characteristic that until that time when you enlisted Turkish support the Turkish Cypriot minority lived on excellent Terms with their Greek Cypriot fellowcitizens, who constitute, (a fact you also omit to mention), the 82% of that Greek Island's indigenous population. Before you so incited them the interest of Turkey in Cyprus was scant indeed moreover.

It is intriguing to note your obstinate insistence in the utter futility of a policy aiming to deprive the right of self determination to a European people, at a time when, for better or for worse, even all

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cannibal communities had already been promoted to statehood & granted the status of UN membership.

Incidentally it was also for this right to selfdetermination, amongst other things (Freedom & such) which we fought for, side by side, in two world wars, during which the Turks were consistently in the opposite camp.

Be that as it may what I wish to point out is that the statements contained in your editorial in question together with those in Mr Fields' article correctly insist on the guilt of what you rightly term as "The folly of the late Greek military regime". But you surprisngly (?) disregard the fact that it was the USA Government's various Agencies who, after having successfully conspired to put their beloved Junta in power, it was they, and they alone, who sustained them there for seven and a half dark and revolting years which ended in a first scale catastrophe both for Greece and for Cyprus, but in a triumphant success of long hatched sinister plots of american inspiration.

These plots aimed at the attainment of goals set long ago by American Agencies in close collaboration with their Turkish friends who only waited for the golden opportunity to put into effect their well prepared plans, of premeditated aggression. Attempts had been made on a number of occasions in the past. But now at last the stage was set. And the occasion to make full use of it was offered by the criminal initiative taken at the instigation of American Governmental Agencies by their Athens stooges, in other words the thugs they had forced upon <sup>the</sup> Freedom loving peaceful Greek people.

Therefore it certainly is not a case of unjustified "anti American hysteria" as you put it, nor has "Greek public opinion... so eagerly offered itself as fuel for the Leftwing agitators" so as to be held, as you maintain, responsible for the tragedy of the american ambassador's death from, as now admitted, a stray bullet. A tragedy exclusively in fact serving Turkish interests which the Turks were quick in exploiting. Neither are the Greeks "looking for scapegoats in the midst of their disaster", the instigators of which are certainly not the Greek People nor their elected leaders.

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It is rather the other way round. The Greeks are fully aware of the fact, if you are not, that the provocation which served as the long sought after pretext for the, since long ago carefully planned, Turkish invasion stemmed from the initiative of the subagents of the various USA Agencies who gave them their blessing. Their stooges thus walked into the trap, carefully prepared for them and for Greece, by their masters, fully scorning the true interests of the Greek Nation. A practice which, by the way, they consistently followed during all those long years during which the Americans had them forced upon us, dictating their orders to them in whatever, as Americans, they considered to serve american interests, true or imaginary. On the other hand it is of course a fatal fallacy, showing a truly deep ignorance of historic realities, to dare imagine that in the long run it is feasible for a small minority of mostly uncouth peasants to subjugate permanently a civilised people constituting the 82% of the population, while violating in the process all human rights. But this is just another characteristic instance of political immaturity and of the blindness of American policy which has led to the USA and the Free World having already lost the three quarters of the Globe. And the losses continue.

Thus the USA handling of the whole matter, after first having connived in the acts of folly committed by their idiot stooges in Athens at their instigation, so as to lead them into the trap they had set for them, is treachery par excellence, as exemplified by Dr Kissinger's tactics in whole affair. Nothing more, nothing less.

And, so as to complete the picture, american forces effectively prevented any aid from the Greek mainland, however scant, to go to the assistance of the victims of the Turkish aggression. (Perhaps in the spirit of a second Yalta sell out?)

And all this at the cost of thousands of lives, 250 thousand refugees, untold misery &, in spite of your ideas to the contrary, the inevitable usual atrocities in which the gallant Turkish forces, heavily armed by the USA, always specialise in, at the expense of defenceless, of course, people. An unholy alliance between Chicago

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gangsters and Mongul barbarians.

These then are the reasons (and not hysteria) for which, united in adversity and in its determination to survive at whatever price, the, hellenic nation, immune to despair after having experienced all sorts of disasters suffered at various instances in the last four thousand years, today to a man, from the extreme left to the extreme right, abhors, and shall for long years to come continue to abhor, everything american. The Turk we say, some day, out of obvious necessity, forced upon us by geographical etc circumstances, be obliged to absolve, trying hard, after rectification of the wrongs once again suffered by us at his hands, to forget. The American Administration's deeds: never!

Which irredicable memory shall live irrespectively of politics & policies.
