GENEVA, JULY 7 (AP)—THE DISMISSAL OF THE PRESIDENT OF THE STATE COUNCIL IN GREECE AND HIS REPLACEMENT BY A GOVERNMENT NOMINEE WERE CONDEMNED BY THE INTERNATIONAL COMMISSION OF JURISTS (ICJ) MONDAY AS "FURTHER ILLUSTRATIONS OF THE AUTHORITIES' CONTEMPT FOR THE RULES GOVERNING THE DEMOCRATIC EXERCISES OF POWER."

"THE SIMULTANEOUS ARREST AND DEPORTATION OF SEVERAL LAWYERS GIVES RISE TO THE GRAVEST APPREHENSION AS TO WHAT CAN BE EXPECTED BY THOSE WHO UNDERTAKE TO DEFEND THE BULL OF LAW IN GREECE," IT SAID.

COMMENTING ON THE 18 OUT OF THE 25 MEMBERS OF THE STATE COUNCIL WHOSE RESIGNATION WAS DEMANDED, OR WHO RESIGNED OUT OF PROTEST, THE ICJ SAID: "THEY HAVE EARNED THE ADMIRATION OF LAWYERS THE WORLD OVER. THEIR COURAGEOUS AND DIGNIFIED ACTION DEMONSTRATED THEIR LOYALTY TO THE RULE OF LAW AND TO THE TRADITIONS OF THEIR PROFESSION."

THE ICJ IS A PRIVATE ORGANIZATION, WITH UNITED NATIONS CONSULTATIVE STATUS, AND DRAWS SUPPORT FROM MORE THAN 45,000 JURISTS ON ALL CONTINENTS.
