Re.: LIPTOL PTOLEMAIS open cast mine conveying plant

We regret that we have up to now received no report, enquiries, etc. from the LIPTOL MINING AND INDUSTRIAL COMPANY S.A. concerning the PTOLEMAIS conveying plant, especially since we have in our quotation equaled our competitors from a technical point of view and presented far more satisfactory economic conditions.

We are enclosing official documents of the Chamber of Commerce, Essen, in which it is certified that Messrs. Koppers and Messrs. zur Nieden are both in the position to erect open cast mine conveying plants for lignite, as was planned for PTOLEMAIS.

We would also like to refer to the letter of July 6, 1964, from the RHEINISCHE BRAUNKOHLN AKTIENGESELLSCHAFT, Cologne, in which it is certified that Messrs. ZUR NIEDEN supplied (i.e. designed, built, erected and put on stream) for them belt conveyor systems having huge driving capacities (larger than those necessary for the PTOLEMAIS plant) and that this work was completely satisfactory. It is further stated that these conveyor systems have shown an excellent performance.

The confirmation of Rheinische Braunkohlen AG is of special importance, since this company operates the largest open cast mine conveying plants with the biggest working capacities in the Federal Republic of Germany and therefore have a great deal of experience in this field.
