Furthermore, we certify that the two above mentioned companies are cooperating on the conveyor belt system PTOLEMAIS and that the plant will be executed mutually on placement of order.

We enclose a certified photostat copy of a letter of Rheinische Braunkohlenwerke Aktiengesellschaft, Cologne, dated July 6, 1964, in which it is confirmed that the plants erected by Wilhelm zur Nieden, with a maximum capacity of up to 6 x 650 kW, have been constructed and built by Wilhelm zur Nieden themselves and that the orders were settled to the fullest satisfaction of Rheinische Braunkohlenwerke AG, Cologne, and that the entire plant has proved its efficiency in operation.

Rheinische Braunkohlenwerke Aktiengesellschaft, Cologne, is a company which operates about 90 % of the brown coal mines in the Federal Republic of Germany.
