## MEMORANDUM NO.4.

About 17 months ago I signed my agreement with the Greek overament and in spite of many delays beyond my control we have made good progress with designs, economic studies, lade examination, surveys, beringe, and bids. I awarded on April 2 contracts to Arthur G. McKee Go, of Claveland as the Primo Contractior for construction of my complex and we are ready to begin. We have had several mentings to find ways to help the Government in its aménaries to greate more opportunities for employment, increase its exports, and whalever other benefits and searcifices we could make in order to achieve the above.

Belley I shall list some of the additional binefits that I have given which are financially costly to us, but I am making these concessions in order to demonstrate once again my willingness to copperate with you. I hope this right after the holidays we can exchange the appropriate latters.

- We are prepared to increase the petroleum product imports
  to give the Government the opportunity to export its
  agricultural products by at least \$4,000,000. raising the
  total amount from our part to over \$10,000,000. -.
  - Provide a minimum refining guarantee fee of \$4,500,000. -.
     increase additionally the guarantee for the steel plant by
  - \$2,000,000,--
- Install an additional investment for a steam cracker at a cost of about \$12,000,000...
- Additional concession prepare design for expansion of Amnossia plant to 200,000 teas yearly for export requirements which is an additional investment of about \$5,000,000... The above concessions represent a financial advantage to Greece of about \$25,000,000...

Furthermore we are developing export markets for petroleum products which will provide foreign exchange earning of at least 35,000,000. - In addition to the above and as a completely magnanimous commitment on our part which is a separate undertaking. I am prepared to
