Recommendations for a Washington Newsletter on Greece

FROM: TC and JN TO: Z

We recommend the following action:

- Tie into the <u>Athenes-Presse Libre</u> (Generitis) <u>Elevibria</u> (Maxwell), network. Batwase them they physical sophisticated coverage of Greek Beeg both from the Taropean and general Americam point of view. The <u>Elevibria</u> format, which we would be using, is particularly elevant. We can get as many copies as we need by arrangement with Mawwell, who is a good 'riend and a disinterested, non-partiant friend of Greece.
- Produce, as a complement to the above, a two-page Washington weekly newsletter on Greek-American relations, consisting of a) an editorial statement (one half to one page in lenth),
  - b) a succinct summary of developments concerning Greece on the Hill and in the State, Defense and other U.S. Government departments and agencies. We should aim for an accurate and authoritative "insider" style, for maximum impact on the news media.
- Name and affiliation of the Newsletter should be as straightforward and uncomplicated as possible. We recommend "Washington Newsletter on Greece" or some such title, The affiliation "COULD be made clear by a series of signed editorials or excerpts from pertinent atatements by Mr. Ziphdis.
- Distribution: "Major American media: Greek exile publications; Greek diaspora organisations, political, civic, religious, fraternal, cultural, etc.; individuals on our mailing lists; Congressional committies and appropriate Government departments
- Responsibility for production; part I (editorial) could be under the immediate supervision of Mr. Zighdis; part II (news) could be handled by John Nicolopoulos. Overall coordination, the technical side of production and distribution should be handled by Mr. Zighdis' executive assistant.
