

Declaration issued by former Minister J.G.Zigdis

After Vice-President Agnew, Secretary of Defence Laird, Secretary of Commerce Stans, the turn has come for Secretary of State William Rogers to pay a "courtesy visit" to the military regime - despite the fact that he has repeatedly expressed his disappointment at the "slow pace in the restoration of democracy in Greece."

And the question naturally arises, taking on special emphasis on the eve of the anniversary of the Declaration of Independence of the USA:

Which representative of the US government will eventually visit the allied people of his country, who have been in bondage for the last five years? Or better, when is the US government going to understand its obligations to the people of Greece, deriving from the immortal spirit of the Declaration of the 4th July 1776, as well as from the imperative wording of the Treaty of Alliance?

It is unnecessary to underline the consequences of these inconsistencies.
